

Day 1 – 03 OCT (Thur) – Depart the US for Warsaw, Poland

Day 2 - 04 OCT (FRI) - ARRIVE WARSAW, POLAND

Welcome to Poland! Individual transfers to your accommodations are arranged. Meet your Tour Director this afternoon in the hotel lobby. Tour and Private Mass at St. John's Archcathedral - contingent on availability. Welcome Dinner at the hotel this evening. (D)

Day 3 – 05 OCT (SAT) – WARSAW

Tour St Anne's Church, followed by a private celebration of Mass. Visit the Museum of King Jan III's Palace at Wilanow. Tour Holy Cross Church, burial site of Chopin's heart. Dinner at a local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 4 - 06 OCT (SUN) - WARSAW - NIEPOKALANOW - CZESTOCHOWA

Visit the Museum of St. Maximilian Kolbe. Entrance to the Firefighter Papal Museum. Celebrate private Mass in the Chapel of St. Maximilian Kolbe. Tour the Basilica of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Coach through the countryside to Czestochowa for dinner at a local restaurant and overnight. (B,D)

Day 5 – 07 OCT (MON) – CZESTOCHOWA – KRAKOW

Tour Jasna Góra Monastery, home to the Black Madonna. Celebrate private Mass and venerate the Black Madona. Free time to spend in prayer and reflection at the monastery. Onwards to Krakow. Dinner at your hotel this evening. (B,D)

Day 6-08 OCT (TUE) - KRAKOW. EXCURSION TO AUSCHWITZ

Tour Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camp. Explore St. Maximilian Kolbe's cell and the Martyrdom Museum. Celebrate Private Mass at the Auschwitz chapel. Return to Krakow for dinner at your hotel. (B,D)

Day 7 – 09 OCT (WED) – KRAKOW. EXCURSION TO WADOWICE

Today visit the birthplace of beloved Pope John Paul II in the town of Wadowice. Explore his family home. Attend Private Mass at the Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary where St. John Paul II was baptized. Return to Krakow for dinner at a local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 8 - 10 OCT (THU) - KRAKOW. EXCURSION TO ŁAGIEWNIKI

Visit and Tour the Sanctuary of Divine Mercy. Participate in Private Mass at the Łagiewniki Shrine in the chapel of the miraculous image of the Merciful Jesus and the tomb of St. Faustina. Special Polish Evening! No trip to Poland is complete without a little polka! This fun evening showcases the traditional 19th-century dance that originated in Bohemia. Join your Tour Director for an authentic dinner of Polish specialties with wine, coffee, and lively polka music and dancing. (B,D)

Day 9 - 11 OCT (FRI) - KRAKOW

Tour the Archbishops cathedral. Celebrate private Mass in the private chapel - contingent on availability. Tour the burial place of Polish kings and bishops, and the place where St. John Paul was ordained a bishop, Wawel Cathedral. See the famous bugle tower when you visit St. Mary's Basilica. Enjoy a guide tour of the tour Wawel Royal Castle. Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant. (B,D)

Day 10 - 12 OCT (SAT) - DEPART KRAKOW, POLAND
